## Sports Awards closes season

The curtain came down on the 2008-09 Good Shepherd Catholic School athletics season Tuesday, May 19, with our annual Sports Awards Night ceremony.

**Leah Freeman** and **Matthew Aguirre** were presented with the prestigious Christian Athlete of the Year awards.

The 8th grade girls volleyball team (**Cassidy Donaldson, Leah Freeman, Neddi Gleitsmann, Olivia Locatelli, Britain Lonie, Katie McGrogan, and Alex Pulpan**) was named Team of the Year and Academic Team of the Year. The girls accumulative GPA this year is 3.58.

**Neddi Gleitsmann** was presented with the seventh annual Dave Stevenson Memorial Award of Courage. The award goes to the athlete who best displays exemplary courage and Christian values.

**Cassidy Donaldson** received the Scholar Athlete of the Year award for the second year in a row. She has a 4.0 GPA this year.

**Gaby Espinoza, Matt Marani, Marcel Herred** and **Katie McGrogan** were each selected Student Athlete of the Year in grades 5 through 8, respectively. For McGrogan, it marks the fourth year in a row she has won the award.

The first Dan Barnard Memorial Honor Coach of the Year Award was given to Kate Butler. The award is presented annually, in recognition of Barnard, to the Good Shepherd Catholic School coach who best embodies the philosophies and principles of the Good Shepherd Athletics Program.

Butler, a 2004 graduate of Good Shepherd, coached the 7th grade girls volleyball team to its second straight undefeated season. She also helped with some of the 5th grade practices at the start of the season and coached the 8th grade for a match when its coaches were out of town.

The award was presented by Barnard's wife, Debra, and son, Zach.
